EXPERIENCE

His experience also includes working with the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation (PBGC) to calculate benefits and create benefit statements for terminated pension plans.

He also has experience with managing and reviewing technical calculations of plan liabilities and providing analysis for special actuarial studies. He has been involved in all aspects of actuarial valuations, including reconciling and manipulating data, calculating benefit statements, preparing government filings, and preparing client correspondences and actuarial reports.

Since rejoining Milliman, Erik has been involved with actuarial valuations for OPEB plans sponsored by approximately 100 Virginia entities, most of which were referred to our firm by the Virginia Municipal League/Virginia Association of Counties (VML/VACo).
